

FISHERY RULES

We expect that all our customers will put the welfare of the fish, their fellow angler and the environment of these lakes before their own pleasure and convenience.

In the interests of health, safety it is essential that all our customers can speak and read English or are accompanied by someone who can.

We will, without warning, ask the police to remove anyone who is drunk, loud mouthed, violent or taking, sharing or peddling **any illegal drug substance.**

BANNED

Barbed or micro barbed hooks

All nut baits AND ALL BREAD

Trout pellets

ALL DOGS

Fires

Barbeques which are not well off the grass and away from vegetation

Carp in keep nets or sacks (except matches)

Heavy handed baiting.

Anglers under 12 unless with adult over 18

Night anglers under 16 unless with parent

Removing fish from the fishery. This will be treated as theft and the Police called.

ADDITIONAL RULES FOR THE CARP LAKE.

Our policy in the past three years has been to remove small fish from the carp lake and keep the bigger ones so that they have the chance to grow. As a result we have 3 fish that are now close to 30lbs and another 4 fish over 20 lbs and many more in the upper teens. This has made the fishing much more challenging than it used to be. It is important for the welfare of these big fish that they are handled properly. That is why these additional rules are required for this lake.

1. All landing nets will be a minimum of 30 inches 600mm wide preferably 42 inches.
2. All anglers will have immediate access to a padded unhooking mat.
3. Only safety rigs will be used and all ledger and method feeding rigs will have 1metre of leadcore or tubing behind the lead. Mainline should be 10lbs minimum.
4. All top fishing rigs will include an elasticated float or 'Candle'

YOU MUST

Book for night fishing. We do not accept everybody for night fishing and it is not always available. Places are limited so do not put up your bivvy until you know it is OK. Night fishing finishes at the end of October and starts again at the end of March.

Take all rubbish home. All rubbish around a swim is yours.
A black bag will be provided on request

Fish from the platforms provided and not trample the vegetation in the margins

Have your environment agency Rod licence with you. Two licences if you want to fish with three rods. **BEWARE** we are checked regularly by the EA bailiff
